

TEXAS ASH

FRAXINUS texensis 'Texas' Ash



- Height: 50'
Spread: 40'
Shape: short trunk supporting a spreading, broad and rounded crown
Foliage: Deciduous, The leaves are dark green to olive green above and paler green below and cast a medium shade beneath the tree. Petioles are an attractive pale red to pink
Fall Color: fall color is showy ranging from orange/red to purple
Hardiness: 7
Comments: Texas Ash creates a wonderful shade tree, its short trunk supporting a broad, rounded crown of seven-inch-long leaves divided into leaflets
